WARNING: Car Parking around the Comeraghs Area

Recently members of our Club while on a Sunday walk had their vehicles (which were parked at car parks around the Comeraghs) broken into and some items were taken as a result so please Club Members be very cautious as to what you leave visible in the car, any valuables should be kept somewhere safe and out of view or on your person during the walk.

Please be vigilant when parking your car in any of the Comeragh car parks as to your valuables not being left in sight and if any suspicious cars or other vehicles are seen around, please note the REG number or any outstanding details that can assist the Gardai if ever needed.

Beware of Lambing/Calving Season

Consideration is required over the coming months for any local farmers who have sheep lambing or cows calving, try not to disturb them when walking near or towards any farmlands where they graze, as any sudden movements or fright can cause the animals to lose their young.
